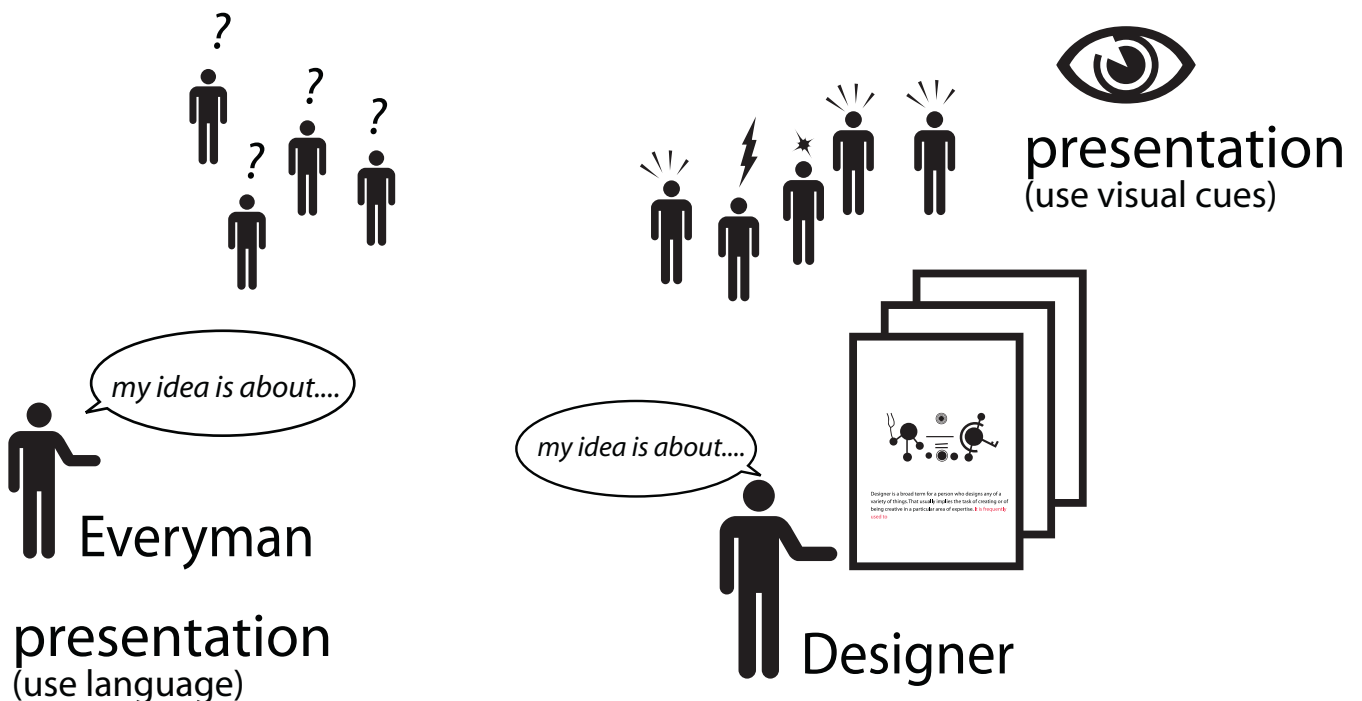
What is designer?

That usually implies the task of creating or of being creative in a particular area of expertise. **It is frequently used to reference someone who draws or in some ways uses visual cues to organize their work.** Designers are usually responsible for making a model that takes into consideration each step in a product's development, including not only how a product will be used but also how it will be made.
